The summit began with an impactful keynote address by Kevin Fleming, whose thought-provoking presentation challenged traditional views in education. Fleming's message on work-based learning (WBL) and the importance of discovering personal purpose resonated deeply with attendees. His authentic storytelling and personal journey made his talk even more memorable, with one listener remarking, "You wouldn't be saying what you delivered today without walking the path you lived." 
