Strengthening Pathways with ARCHES: WE Will! PBL Workshop Impacts Gustine Unified Schools

In June, ten dedicated educators from Gustine High School participated in a transformative twoday Project Based Learning (PBL)



workshop sponsored by the WE Will! Collaborative that exemplified the collaborative approach needed between K-12 education and industry partners.

The diverse group included business pathway, patient care pathway, mathematics, and arts teachers, demonstrating how PBL can bridge

academic disciplines while preparing students for real-world careers. Participants designed authentic units of study, moving beyond traditional classroom approaches to create learning experiences that mirror actual workplace challenges and skill building as well as integrating work based learning experiences with industry partners in the form of guest speakers, industry tours, industry mentoring and informational interviews.
