





About the WE Will! K16 Taskforces

The Education and Healthcare Task Forces meet monthly to implement their respective occupational pathways, incorporating industry-connected courses and work-based learning experiences across K-12, community colleges, and CSU/UC systems. Their primary goal is to achieve the K16 Required Pathway Outcomes, coordinate the partners in each pathway to meet regional objectives, address overlapping professional learning needs, and manage education data collection.

Each task force is co-chaired by two members from the collaborative area. The co-chairs facilitate meetings and ensure progress within their counties. They are also responsible for providing monthly updates to the WE Will! Design Team, presenting items for review and approval to the Executive Council, and attending Design Team meetings.
